Grandfather of Chris Gray Hardy, P.C., Fla., and greatgrandfather of Bobby Hutchins.

Information on this family was provided by Chris Gray Hardy, Bobby Hutchins and Johnnie Rease Owens Corpuz, who married Joseph's greatgrandson J C Miles, her second cousin once removed.

Sion was a farmer and also public works. Buried at Mashburn Cemetery, Youngstown, Bay County,

FL. After his death, Lillie Mae married Lem Miles. Lillie Mae buried at Galilee, Jackson County, FL.

4. JOSEPH LEVIN (BUDDY)³ GRAY (*JOSEPH², JOSEPH¹*) was born 22 Feb 1880 in Alabama^{35,36}, and died 22 Feb 1954^{37,38}. He married SARAH ELLEN HATCHER Abt. 1904³⁹. She was born 23 Mar 1888^{40,41}, and died 18 Feb 1953^{41,42}.

Notes for JOSEPH LEVIN (BUDDY) GRAY:

Age 3/12 on 1880 census, although birthdate given on 1900 census was 1879. Known as "Buddy" to family. Name Ellen Hatcher came from Rease Owens Corpuz, Chris Gray Hardy and Levin's daughter Rethie.

Interview with Ellen Moses Jones, dau of Allie Mae Gray Moses, 19 July 2003, Panama City, Florida:

Levin and Ellen Hatcher were separated, but never divorced. She said her grandfather died 22 Feb 1954. Three of Levin and Ellen Hatcher Gray's daughters married three Moses brothers.

What is the story behind the 'A L Gray' instead of 'J L Gray' in the marriage license? These must be different people, not Buddy and Ellen, although the marriage date is right for them. There were other Grays and Hatchers in the area.

Scanned all Jackson County 1900- - no other familiar names. No Ellen Hatchers. Couple of Wm Hatchers, one with wife Ella, age 37, and 2 Lewis stepchildren, pg 308B, #177. Only Gray found was Shane Gray, 38, widower, pg 308B, #174.

Phone conversation with Willie Ruth Gray, Oakland California, 28 May 2002:

She confirmed that Levin was buried at Beulah Cemetery in (or near) Chipley. (There is a pew in the church that Charles Washington Gray donated .) His oldest son was named Joseph, who went off to New York and never came back. (He is the one listed as Daniel J on the 1910 census.)

Notes for ALICE (ALLIE) MAE GRAY:

Died when youngest child, Ellen, was 14 months old. Her father, Joseph Levin, and her sisters raised her children. Jeannette stayed with Branch Moses (Walter's brother) and his wife Jewel.

She and her brother Daniel Joseph (Joe) had the same birth day and month.

Ellen Moses Jones said that her mother died of a heart attack. Allie had been sickly all her life and did not work in the fields or turpentine with the other children as they grew up. About the time she died, Allie and Walter Moses were both sick at the same time, he with rheumatoid arthritis. When Allie died, Ellen was sent to live with her aunt Lela Moses Daniels. The other children stayed with grandparents

Levin and Ellen until Walter got better. He later died at the home of his brother Jim Moses and his wife, Martha Gray Moses.

Notes for DANIEL JOSEPH GRAY:

Rethie said that her brother left his wife and child with his parents while he went off to find work (she didn't know where). They had one letter from him saying he was sick with pneumonia, but they never heard from him again. They tried to find out what happened to him, but never found out anything. His daughter, Louise, stayed with Rethie after she married.

Ellen Moses mentioned that maybe one of her Aunt Martha's sons went with Joe (possibly to New York) and they never heard of him again, either, but she wasn't sure. It happened before Ellen was born.

Gray, and that the children had laughed at the strange middle name. (No idea how to spell that name.)

She remembered a John Gray who she thought was her father's cousin. He had children Buddy, Duck (a girl) and Mattie?, or Mattie or Hattie may have been his wife. (note: This John Gray might have been Daniel J Gray's son John C from Calhoun County. His wife was named Addie.)

All information on this family (except census entries, marriage info and Nancy's middle initial, which came from marriage entry) was transcribed from a family sheet and letters obtained by Bobby Hutchins, grandson of Charles Washington Gray, during his research. They were apparently created by a Tom Stillman of Altoona, Pa about 1985. He was grandson of Nancy Gray Chatwood, dau of Joseph Gray, Jr and Sarah Frances Duncan. His family sheet gave 20 May 1882 as birth date for Nancy, but the 1900 census gave 1884, as she was 16. Husband's birthdate (32 years older than she was) is as given on the family sheet. The 1910 census showed him about 26 years older than she was.

According to Stillman, Nancy Gray's death certificate gave her father's birthplace as Ft. Wayne, Ind. Where this idea came from, no one knows. Also, his note said that Martin had been married previously and had 7 children by first wife, Mary Malissa Kelly.
