(1849 came from Lavinia's family sheet.)

< But I sure was hit in the face with a piece of new evidence on the husband of my great grandmother, Martha Gray Milton. This happened about three weeks ago. Richard Milton disappeared about 1890-1895. He was thought possibly dead. NOW, it appears he returned to Georgia and MARRIED AGAIN!!!, and had another family. Oh well, my grandmother did not have to know - or my dad. >

Is this any of his family? He was in the area of Dale County where Richard and Martha Gray Milton and Joseph & Mary Gray were in 1880.
