Carl Gray was a local politician in Panama City, Florida, where we lived during the late 1950s.

My grandmother Mary Etta Gray Owens always said that Carl's grandfather and her father were brothers. This does not now seem very likely or even possible, since we have accounted for all the brothers of her father, Andrew Jackson Gray, that we know of. I thought once that maybe she was a generation off, and maybe it was Carl's greatgrandfather and her grandfather who were brothers. This would make Hosea Clark Gray the brother of Joseph Gray of Geneva. But Hosea's father appears to be the Joseph C Gray who was age 44 on the 1850 Pulaski Co., Ga, census and who is about the same age as our Joseph.

It seems likely now that she had Carl's family confused with that of Christine Gray of Panama City, whose grandfather was Joseph Gray, Jr, brother to Etta's father, Andrew Jackson Gray.

I had a phone conversation with Carl Gray some time around 1979-80. He seemed confused, and rambled from one subject to another. His greatgrandfather Hosea Clark Gray and his wife Anna Paramore (around Blakely, Ga.) were as far back as he knew, but he said his grandfather was John and his remembered a Martin. He had an Aunt Martha, and a first cousin named Corine Gray Lindley.

Finding Corine as daughter of Joseph S Gray of Millville on the 1910 and 1920 censuses, I had assumed that Joseph S must be brother to Carl's father. Joseph S is buried in the same cemetery lot as John C Gray, so I'm assuming that he was John's son. Carl's father is listed as Hosie on the 1920 census and R H on the 1935 Florida state census. The tombstone gives "Robert Hosea".

Note 27 Feb 2005: I think that Robert Hosea, Joseph Sylvester and William Benjamin were all sons of John Clark Gray, buried at Millville.

In 1905, G.M.B. Harries moved to Millville for employment with the German American Lumber Co. On May 26, 1906, he married Adele Bovis. She was the daughter of Henry Bovis, the founder of the St. Andrews Lumber Co., which became the German American Lumber Co. Harries served as Bay County's first tax assessor from 1913-1924. From 1925-1935 he was active in the real estate and abstract business. Harries died unexpectedly at the age of 62, March 25, 1935, on the beach while seeking relief from a severe asthma attack. He was buried in Greenwood Cemetery.

While developers eyed St. Andrew in the 1880s, Samuel J. Erwin, Green B. Thompson, and Clark B. Slade took up homesteads on the land that would become Panama City. C. J. Demorest and G. W. Jenks surveyed some of this property and platted it as the Town of Harrison on September 20, 1883. This survey showed Harrison Avenue where it runs today. The Harrison post office opened on the waterfront on January 14, 1889. The financial panic of 1892 bought doom to this project and any interest in future land sales. Harrison remained a small trading post where a total of four families resided year round. The original owners retained rights to most of the land until the early 1900s.

The area's reawakening began in Millville when Henry Bovis, a French Canadian with lumber interests in Bagdad, Florida, surveyed the bay and seemingly inexhaustible surrounding forests. Bovis constructed a mill at the head of Watson Bayou and called it the St. Andrews Lumber Co. Those seeking work flocked to the mill town. The Millville post office opened on September 20, 1899.

In 1904, service at the Harrison post office was discontinued and moved to Millville. . .

. . .In 1910, Henry Bovis sold the St. Andrews Lumber Co. to a foreign syndicate and it became known as the German-American Lumber Co. Hundreds moved to Millville to work at this huge mill. By 1910, Millville ranked as the bay's largest community, one that went on to produce many of this area's most influential sons and daughters. <end excerpt>
