

Descendants of Nancy Gray

Generation No. 1

1. NANCY² GRAY (*JOSEPH*¹) was born 1830 in North Carolina^{1,2,3}, and died 1914⁴. She married ISAAC WILLIAMS 27 Dec 1855 in Worth County, Georgia⁵. He was born 1829⁶, and died 1875^{7,8,9}.

Notes for NANCY GRAY:

Her grave marker is still intact, a rounded wooden marker probably of cypress, as it has held up for 90 years now. I thought I could almost see traces of the name Williams carved in the face, but that may have been my imagination, as the wood is cracked and weathered. The bottom of the marker is beginning to show severe decay. Isaac's marker is almost gone and has only a stump left, but it has been 129 years since he died. Someone has placed metal markers from Lewis-Sowell Funeral Home with her and Isaac's personal information on them.

Santa Rosa County, Reverse Index to Deeds, on microfilm at Fl State Archives, Mar 2005: No deeds found to Isaac or Nancy Williams. Many deeds found for Daniel, D T, W J and A J Williams 1889 - 1914.

Heritage of Santa Rosa County book: many Williams references in index; scanned those on first 300 pages of book; nothing familiar.

Nancy's grave marker says she died in 1914, but I have not found her on census for 1900 or 1910.

***Note: census was supposed to reflect status as of 1 June. Therefore, Nancy's age agrees with her grave marker that she was born in 1830, and had already had her 1860 birthday. However, 1850 census (also as of 1 June) shows her as only 19, meaning she had not had her 1850 birthday yet, so we don't know which is correct.

At dwelling and family #427 on same page set (179B) is brother John C Gray and family.

From this census, it appears that Nancy and Isaac stayed in Georgia until after about 1870-71 when Hilliard was born, although the 1885 census has Andrew Jackson, Martha and Hilliard born in Alabama. If they moved to Coffee Co. at the same time as Joseph (late 1860) it would be reasonable to think that John, also, had been born in Alabama.

Notes: This cemetery is located south of Milton in the historical town of Bagdad. Go west on Highway 90 from Milton until you come to the red light at Parkmore Plaza Road and take a left. On Parkmore Plaza Road go to the four-way stop sign and take a left on the Old Bagdad Road. Go 1.4 miles on Old Bagdad Road until you come to Burtonwood Road and take a right, cemetery is on the left-hand side of the road. Many unknown graves are in this cemetery. At one time the African-American and white sections were known, now it is all together with no known barrier. This cemetery does not even have a sign telling the name of the cemetery. (wrn Note: Yes, there is a historic marker sign - as of Oct 2004.)

2. DANIEL ARTIS³ WILLIAMS (*NANCY² GRAY, JOSEPH¹*)¹⁵ was born 05 Dec 1856 in Georgia^{16,17,18}, and died 30 Dec 1932¹⁹. He married JOANNA REEVES^{20,21} 15 Jul 1882 in Santa Rosa County, Florida^{22,23}. She was born 11 Nov 1864 in Alabama^{24,25}, and died 24 Feb 1936²⁶.

Notes for DANIEL ARTIS WILLIAMS:

Birth year uncertain. Parents married Dec 1855. Age 2 on 1860 Worth Co., Ga (giving birth date of 1857, if he was born in Dec). Age 23 on 1880 Santa Rosa Co., Florida census (would give date 1856), age 44 on 1900 census (would give date 1855), 1910 census age 53 would give 1856.

I am judging from the age, location, parental birthplaces and number of years married (as reported on 1910 census) that this is Nancy Gray Williams' son. He and Joanna and their son Joseph Edward all have identical plain stones at Bagdad Cemetery. Daniel, Jr has a Woodmen of the World memorial stone. All four are buried near Nancy, Isaac, Daniel Artis, Joanna and Joseph Edward. John C and Sarah are some distance away in another section. There is another grave with a stone that I could not read in the rain, and the photo is not clear. It appears to read "?? Williams, Nov 2? 1898? ?? 1900". (According to the Jernigan compilation, this is Lawrence L.)
