1. MARY (POLLY) ANN² GRAY (*JOSEPH*¹) was born 29 Jan 1844 in Georgia¹, and died 05 Feb 1904 in Geneva County, Alabama². She married (1) SAMUEL COWAN Aft. Jul 1860, son of JOHN COWAN and MARY UNKNOWN. He was born Abt. 1836³, and died Aft. 06 Jan 1865⁴. She married (2) GEORGE WASHINGTON LEDDON, SR Abt. 1866, son of ALFRED LEDDON and MARY GANUS. He was born 27 Sep 1842 in North Carolina⁵, and died 12 Nov 1928⁵.

Notes for MARY (POLLY) ANN GRAY:

Leddon Cemetery is on HWY 83, south of HWY 52 between Samson and Geneva, Alabama.

Birthdate given as Jan 1845 on 1900 census, but her age was 54; if she was born in 1844 (as on tombstone), she should have been 56.

At the foot of Polly Ann's grave at Leddon Cemetery is:

Mary Frances, wife of James A Killingsworth Mar 6, 1873 - May 29, 1902

This person is same age as Dirley on 1880 census. Who is this person? See note on Dirley 1880, but see also email below from internet bulletin board concerning Dirley Savannah Leddon.

Gene Gray (son of A J Gray, Jr) and Gladys Watson Gray (wife of Clarence) were aware that Polly Ann was the elder A J's sister. Gladys had known Polly Ann's daughters Carrel (pronounced Carl) and Abby, as "cousins". Gladys also thought that Minnie Leddon Smith was still living in Milton, Florida. But this was Feb 1985, which would make Minnie almost 100 years old. (note: Minnie died 12 Aug 1984, according to Lavinia Helms of Enterprise, Al.) Gladys also knew that Polly Ann was married to a Cowan before she married G W Leddon and that three of her daughters had married Killingsworths. (see notes below)

Children's birthdates calculated from census: Geneva County 1870, 1880, 1900 Marl. The 1870 census gave a misleading impression as to her name. Many people have transcribed it as Margaret, including myself the first time I saw it on a microfilm reader, but magnifying it from a CD copy shows it is not Margaret - - it is Mary ann. See census notes below.

What is the relationship of the Mitchell Gray listed as adopted son on the 1900 census? On 1910 census, there is a Michael Gray, 21, occupation: servant, living in the household of Daniel F. Powell. Could this be the same person as Mitchell Gray? A Mitchell Gray, age 31, born Ala., also appears on 1920 Washington Co., Fla. census with wife Rittie J. and 4 children. Same person? (Note Feb 2000: probably all same person; from Ana Montero's Gray family.)

John G Cowan, of Panama City, Fl, has a website (http://www.geocities.com/Athens/1088/gecow80.html) on which he states: "The widow who came to Geneva County with John Glover Cowan was Mary, the widow of Samuel Cowan, a son of John G. Cowan."

This is highly questionable, since the Cowans were in Barbour County in 1850 and the Grays were in Dooly Co, Ga then and Worth Co in 1860 when Mary Ann was still at home with her family. I know of no evidence that suggests there was any contact between the two families before they both moved to Coffee/Geneva Co, Alabama. Mary Ann's father bought land in Coffee Co in Aug 1861, and presumably moved his family there around that time.

(In 1880, pg 644D, she was 42, a farm hand in household of George & Amanda Crews. She was listed as born in Ga, both parents from SC.)

Note: The ending of Mary Ann's name is hard to read; "an?" is separate but not capitalized and the second "n" is hard to make out; other marks above the "an?" (that look like "H1") make the ending of her name look like "arttt" and may be misread as Margaret, but it is definitely "Mary an?". Also, this census taker's number 4 often looks like a 2, i.e., his 2s have no serif and the 4s look like a 2 with a serif, so her age could easily be mistaken for 22.

A J Gray and W M Stafford attested to his service by affidavits of 15 Mar 1906.

Application of 20 July 1909: enlisted Co D, 54th Al on 20 Sep 1861 at Geneva; age is 67, unable to make a living on account of old age, blindness and general bad health; signed his x mark. On Geneva pension roll 4th class and wants to be raised to second class.

On 20 July 1909: letter from R L Justice, MD: he is 67, totally disabled, suffers from aneurism of the big artery of the abdomen, also with insufficiency of the heart. Has to be attended by another person all the time.

In the old Leddon Cemetery is dates of all Leddon's mostly, but perhaps if you could know 'em it can be figured out. I was up there about month ago, and I didn't know so many Leddon's existed. Polly Ann is buried there also by George. There is an ole' Bible of the family some place but dont know where it is. Mary Virginia is my mother. Aunt Minnie Smith (Leddon) has a Birthday Reunion on her Birthday. Her address: 305 Hunt st. Milton, Fla 32507. She will have the reunion on 20th of Nov. this year. Harvey Leddon, Orlando, Fla, just phoned me that he may go, and if he does, I may come too, to the Reunion. Aunt Minnie is the only one of the Leddon's living and she is 86.

If I could find out where the ole' Bible is I want to get it. I'm the oldest Leddon grandchild. If I had time and all to write, I can tell you some History my mother had the Grey family I knew several. The one in Coffee Springs, I knew all her children but forgot her name and children she had Alice, Ida Mathews she died last month, 86, Susie seem like anyway one of 'em her dau got an injury (girl) and always wasn't too good after that. I believe Alice is dead, her son was Judge Dan Roach in Jeneva, he died years ago, his son an Army big wig died recently (Rex). Oh yes, her name was ----- Noblin. I knew Aunt Sallie, she in her age fell down stairs with lighted lamp & it burned up house and all, she was badly burned. Poor ole' Uncle John Grey he & Aunt Sallie use to come live with us very often. They were Bro & sister of your mother. (Note by wrm: she means Lavinia's greatgrandmother, not mother, as John and Sallie were brother and sister to Polly Ann and to Martha Gray Milton.)

Oh! by the way I see your name is Helms. I wonder if you can be one of the Helms from Newton, Ala. That was my mother-in-laws name.

I hope you can come to Fla. some time and we can catch up on some of all the things. Why not come. I'd like to have you, and I have a big home out in country in middle of orange grove.

There were 5 of us. My mother married a Stanley (W.C.). I am the oldest (Cora), Bernice Gunter, lives in Tampa, Willie Neal lives in Panama City, Fla. Rex Stanley lives in Panama City. Roy Stanley lives in Sun City, Arizona. I was out last year to see him. Hes retired. Barney Stanly is a half Bro. Lives in P. C. and is on top with International Paper Mill there.

If can, come down sometime and maybe I can go to Reunion. Glad to hear from you.


