A James Cumbie received a homestead land patent in 1891 Geneva County S36 T3N R21E, just northeast of Coffee Springs. (This may be the James (J) Cumbie who married Mary Hatton and lived near Coffee Springs.) This is only 3 sections away from land homesteaded by a Joseph C Gray in 1891 and about 4 sections away from land homesteaded by William Beaman, husband of Matilda Gray.
