

## *Descendants of Griffin W Holland*

### *Generation No. 1*

1. GRIFFIN W<sup>1</sup> HOLLAND was born Abt. 1806 in Virginia<sup>1</sup>, and died Bef. 01 Jun 1880<sup>2</sup>. He married (1) ELIZABETH WALKER<sup>3,4</sup> 29 Jul 1829 in Screven County, Georgia<sup>5</sup>. She died Bet. 07 Feb 1838 - 28 Jul 1839<sup>6</sup>. He married (2) MARGARET C WHITAKER 15 May 1839 in Leon County, Florida<sup>7</sup>. She was born Abt. 1818 in North Carolina<sup>8</sup>, and died Aft. 1 Jun 1880<sup>9</sup>.

Griffin W Holland was on the Leon Co. tax lists for at least the years 1844-1848, as 1 male poll with over 1000 acres of land near Lake Iamonia and from 25 - 60 slaves. (Some unnamed Holland was taxed on the 1851 Gadsden list for 14 slaves, with J Thomas as agent. James Thomas also had 1800 acres, 23 slaves and a sawmill.) G W Holland was married in 1839 to Margaret Whitaker, but he had a prior wife, judging from the two children listed in 1850 who were older than the 11 years he and Margaret had been married. He was 44 and she was 32 in 1850.
