Nothing fits for David. In 1910, there is only one David Holland in US born in 1870-1890 Georgia: age 22, Ga NC Ga, sgl, farm laborer, boarder in household of AJ and Eliza Combest in Boston, Thomas County. His age looks like 22 but may well be 32 because the first digit is a little taller and you can see on the next page that many 3's have little tails and look like 2's except slightly taller. If so, this would fit his age of 52 in 1930. Also, there is a Sebron and Ophelia Cumbass living adjacent Julius Holland in 1900 Colquitt, and these same people (as S C and Ophelia Combest) are in the same precinct only 10 entries away from David Halland in Boston in 1910. Also, a few entries away is a JC Cumbest, married 8 years to a wife named Arsillar who is about the same age as Julius Holland's daughter Arsilla. JC is probably the son James in the household of Adam and Liza Cumbest in 1900 and 1920.

Mitchell Co, Ga census of 1900 gives David's birth year as 1886 but the year of 1882 for his brother McNab was at least 6 years off (he was 4 in 1880). David was not on the 1880 census, but his cemetery stone gives birth date of May 1872, and age of 39 in 1920 gives birth year of 1880. Age of 52 in 1930 is two years too old counting from 1920 and would give birth year of 1877, but it fits his age in 1910.

Census of 1930 says he was 52 and married at age 25 giving abt 1903 as marriage year, but that does not fit marriage date to Laura May in 1911, so he would have to have been married before. If 1920 age of 39 is correct and he married at 25, then the prior marriage would have been about 1905. *However, his 1910 census entry shows him to be single*. Laura's age of 26 in 1920 fits her birth year from 1900, but 1930 is off for her and children Joseph and Lillie.

This family is documented here to demonstrate that they were in contact with the Colquitt Hollands and, therefore, it is likely that the David Halland in their household in 1910 is actually David, son of Joseph Holland. They were the only Cumbest families in Thomas County.

There was also a Cumbest-Cumbass family in Mitchell County most of these years.
