

## *Descendants of John Holland*

### *Generation No. 1*

1. JOHN<sup>1</sup> HOLLAND was born Abt. 1798 in North Carolina<sup>1</sup>. He married MARY UNKNOWN. She was born Abt. 1799 in Georgia<sup>2</sup>.

Notes for JOHN HOLLAND:

John and Mary were about 30 when son Haywood was born, so they might have children born before he was. There was a female under 5 listed in their 1830 household.

See **Florida State Genealogical Society Florida Pioneer Application #382** (copy at Florida State Archives) by descendant of Emily, dau of John Holland, the shoemaker. Emily married Jacob George Merritt (b 28 Dec 1841 at Thomasville, Ga; d 13 Sep 1913 at Pelham, Mitchel Co, Ga). That application cites Gadsden censuses 1830-40-50, 1846-47 tax list and 1845 voters list to show John Holland in Florida.

There is an 1856 deed in Leon County (Bk L-pg 235) from John Holland of Gadsden County and his wife Eveline for Lot 6 and the North 1/2 of Lot #5 of Sec 28 T1 R2 N&E containing 120 acres. Who is he? Witnesses: Mary Woodward and RHM Davidson, Jr. He was of Leon County when he bought the land. As John L Holland, he married Emeline Sewell 9 Jun 1853 in Leon County (marriage record has name Emeline instead of Eveline). He appeared on the 1856 and 1857 Gadsden tax roll taxed for 1 male 21-50, too young to be John, the shoemaker.

He is listed nine entries past Briant Vickers. Most of the Vickerses lived near Concord. Nicholas Robinson and two Laings, both Concord names, are on the preceding page. Nathan Shelfer and Redding Blount are on the following page. In 1850, Bryon Vickers, age 65, is 5 entries away from Maria Grey of Concord who is 6 entries past Nicholas Robinson. Nathan Shelfer is adjacent John & Mary Gray of Concord.

1840 US Census, Gadsden County, Florida, pg 97 (left sheet, image #9). Names on this census are grouped alphabetically, so it is impossible to determine where they were located geographically.

Holland, John 1m < 5, 1m 40-50 2f < 5, 3f 5-10, 1f 30-40 No slaves.

One person employed in manufactures or trades.

The boy <5 does not fit Haywood. Mary, Nancy <5; Emily, Sarah 5-10; one dau missing in 1850.

Some people claim that Nicholas Robinson's wife, Elizabeth, was a Holland - John's missing daughter?

She married JONATHAN WILLIAM MERRITT<sup>15</sup> 08 Oct 1857 in Quincy, Gadsden County, Florida<sup>16</sup>, son of RICHARD MERRITT and CATHERINE UNKNOWN. He was born 03 Apr 1839 in Cairo, Grady County, Georgia<sup>17,18</sup>, and died 05 Mar 1892 in Havana, Gadsden County, Florida<sup>19,20</sup>.

Go 1/4 mile on McNair Road and see a grassy lane on the left, with locked gates. This man I was with had a key to the gate given by the hunting club that owns the land. He mows the cemetery and keeps it up because his Laing great-grandparents are buried there. It was absolutely beautiful. About 1,000 square feet with a wrought iron fence around it, just sitting in the middle of woods. There was a 30 foot tall white crape myrtle in the corner, with a trunk so big around I could not reach. . .
