Bk D, pg 578:3 Nov 1832. **William Holland**, the natural guardian of **Jack Holland**, do quitclaim all my claim and my son Jack's claim from the first day of 1836 to a certain tract of land unto John Lane of the same county and territory, until the said Jack Holland comes of age. . . for \$50 paid to me for said Jack Holland by said John Lane for lease of the following tract of land: East half of SE ¼ of Sect 24 T2N R1E containing 80 acres. . . for this time John Lane, his heirs, assigns, etc. shall pay the taxes of said land. Signed: William (his x mark) Holland.

Same page, just below:

29 Oct 1835. Tallahassee. Received of Adam Grambling one hundred dollars being in full for all my right title and claim to the within described land as witness my hand seal. Signed: John Lane

Wit: A J Fisher, Henry Williams.

(Note: there was a BLM-GLO land patent #3201 dated 16 May 1833 in name of Jack Holland for the E ½ of the SE ¼ of Sect 24 T2N R1E. This section is NE of Lake Jackson and south of Lake Iamonia, some 20 miles from the Holland parcels near the Ochlochonee River.)

Bk K, pg 64: 17 July 1849. **Jack Holland** to Adam Grambling, for \$200, the East ½ of the SE ¼ of Sect 24 T2N R1E containing 80 acrs. Signed Jack Holland. Wit: John R Crump, Margaret A Grambling.

Bk G, pg 21: 10 Aug 1839. **William Holland, Jr.**, of Leon Co., to Joseph Reese of Leon Co., for \$125: SW ¼ of SW ¼ of Sec 25 T1N R2W containing 40 and 18/100 acres MOL. Signed: William (his x mark) Holland, Jr. and Sarah J Holland, his wife.

(Note: Patent #7759 for this parcel was issued on 1 Mar 1843 to William Holland. Section 25 touched corners with the Section 23 containing lots #4 and #5 near the Ochlochonee River.)

Also: I, **Sarah J Holland**, wife of William Holland, have granted . . . certain real estate to Elizabeth Holland the lot of land within named, for the sum of one dollar . . . and divers other good and valuable causes and considerations. Signed: Sarah J Holland. Same witnesses.

(Note: On 1840 census, David W Owens was listed adjacent Elijah and Caroline Holland Bryan.)

Bk H, pg 443: 6 Mar 1845. **Elizabeth Holland** of Leon Co. to William Grimes, for \$100, 80 acres: lot #4 of Sect 23 T1N R2W according to the Certificate of the Receiver of Public Lands #8106. Signed her x mark. Wit: Franklin S Johnson and Lewis Grimes.

Bk F, pg 452: 22 Sep 1829. Joseph Bryan to **Elijah Bryan** for \$12, Lot #142 in city of Tallahassee which was conveyed by Romeo Lewis, Sheriff, and Turbutt R Betton, commissioner of the city of Tallahassee. Wit: Augustine Walsh, Turbutt R Betton. Referenced city records for full description of land.

Bk F, pg 453. 1 Dec 1840. **Elijah Bryan** of Leon Co, Fl Terr., to Thomas Brown, for \$50, lot in city of Tallahassee, known as Lot #142. Signed: Elijah Bryan. Also: I, **Caroline Bryan**, wife of Elijah Bryan, release all my right of dower in said lands. . . Signed her x mark.

affection which she the said Roxa Ann Holland bears for her mother, Elizabeth Holland, has this day bargained, etc. conveyed unto said Franklin S Johnson in trust and for the use, benefit and behoof of the said Elizabeth Holland her natural lifetime or widowhood. . . Lot #5 fractional Section 23 T1N R2W containing 40 acres MOL. Signed: Roxa Ann (her x mark) Holland. Wit: Jack Holland and John (his x mark) Barrinow. (No Franklin Johnson on 1850 or 1860 Leon census, but a Francis.)

Bk K, pg 554: 7 Oct 1853. **Roxa Anne Holland** of Leon Co. to Isiah Johnson, Sr, for \$210 (**Josiah? - no Isiah on 1850 census**). . . lot? upon which **Mrs. Elizabeth Holland** last resided. . . North ½ of Lot #5 of fractional Sect 23 T1N R2W containing 40 acres MOL, with the exception that one half acre square of said tract of land upon which the graves are now situated and are by the parties forever to be considered exempt reserved and - - -ated? from sale, and all sales? of the land above specified. . . to be considered as belonging to all persons severally who have deceased relations buried there and any of them interested shall at all times have the right of way to said graveyard. . . Signed: Roxa Anne Holland. Wit: Lionel Fletcher, Richard R Fletcher and **Tom Holland**.

(Note: Tom Holland might have been William Thomas, b. c1843, son of William, Jr. and Sarah J.)

Bk E, pg 53: date? **Griffin W Holland**, of Leon Co. Fl Territory. . . whereas Richard Hayward of the city of Tallahassee has become security to my two certain promissory notes, one for the sum of \$1,303 dated 17 Apr 1835 and payable 12 months after date to David Thomas. . . the other for the sum of \$2,000 dated 9 June 1835 payable six months after date to the order of Richard Hayward at the Central Bank of Florida. . . I, Griffin W Holland for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by Thomas A Austin of same city and county, do hereby sell, etc. to said Thomas A Austin. . . six certain slaves named Mike, Ben, Monday, Harry and Nelly and Daphney. . . in trust nevertheless and to and for the uses, intents and purposes following. . . on default by said Griffin W Holland. . . Thomas A Austin shall . . . sell on the Capitol Square. . . said slaves. . . Signed: G W Holland, Richard Hayward, Thomas A Austin. Note from Hayward and Austin that full amount was paid.

Bk E, pg 500: 7 Feb 1838. **Griffin W Holland** to James R Greene, for \$400, 1.) lot #3 of Sect 13 T3N R1E, 40 acres; 2.) NE ¼ of NE ¼ S14 T3N R1E, 40 acres. Signed: Griffin W Holland and wife **Elizabeth Holland**.

Bk K, pg 105: 12 Nov 1850. **G W Holland**, for natural love and affection which I have and bear my daughter **Virginia E Hayward**, wife of **Robert S Hayward**, and also for divers other good causes and considerations. . . to Richard and Fletcher Whitaker, both of Leon Co. . . lot of land in city of Tallahassee designated on original plan of Tallahassee as lot #290. . . upon trust however to and for the following uses. . . for and during the term of the natural life of the said Virginia E Hayward upon trust to pay the rents, issues and profits to the said Virginia E Hayward. . . or to permit and allow said Virginia E Hayward to have, hold, use, possess and enjoy said property. . . for her sole use and separate benefit, free and discharged from the control and enjoyments of said Robert S Hayward, her present husband or of any future husband, and from and immediately after the decease of said V. E. H, then in trust for the benefit and behoof of the child or children of said V. E. H. living at the time of her death. Signed G W Holland. Wit: C H Austin, James T Archer.

Signed John Holland. Also: I, **Evelyn Holland**, wife of John Holland, release all right of dower. . . Signed: **Eveline Holland**. Wit: Mary Woodward, RHM Davidson, Jr.

(Note: This tract was about 2 miles from the Section 23 where William and Caroline Holland bought lots. He is probably the John L Holland who married Emeline Sewell 9 Jun 1853.)
