

Descendants of Widow Susan Holland

Generation No. 1

1. SUSAN¹ UNKNOWN was born 30 Nov 1796 in North Carolina^{1,2}, and died 10 Jun 1888 in Gadsden County, Florida³. She married UNKNOWN HOLLAND.

Notes for SUSAN UNKNOWN:

This woman may be mother of Mary Jane, wife of Joseph Gray of Geneva County, Alabama. No proof yet. Our only clue is a 1938 document by Abner Preston Leddon, quoting his uncle Oscar Leddon, a son of Polly Ann Gray, in which Oscar recalls his greatgrandmother's death in Quincy, Florida. She was reportedly 113 years old when she died in May 1893 and he thought her name was Holland. Susan (Suannah) Holland is reported to have died in June 1888.

Some information on Holland/Tolar families was given to me in May, 2002 by Gladys Clark Rowan of Sycamore Community, Gadsden County. She is the widow of a greatgrandson of Edy Holland and Larkin Tolar through their daughter Eady Ann. Gladys has copies of birth and death dates from Eady Ann's family Bible listing Suannah Holland (not Susannah), Eady, Suannah Caroline, Larkin Tolar, Bryant Holland, etc. Includes death dates for Suannah, W A Inman (murdered 11 June 1890), and several Rowans and Tolars.

She thinks that Susan (Suannah) might also be buried at Sycamore, although there is no stone for her. She remembered walking through the cemetery several decades ago when she first moved to Sycamore and seeing many wooden markers that have since disappeared.

(Note: maybe her name was Susan Anna and she was called Suannah. ??)

I visited Sycamore Cemetery on 12 Jan 2005. It is quite a large cemetery, on Co. Rd. 270 south of I-10. From the entrance gates on the highway, the old section is in the far rightmost corner, next to a dirt road by a farm. Tolars, Inmans and Rowans are all together in a small area. As the crow flies, it is probably not more than 1.5 miles to Flat Creek Cemetery where Alvin Holland and some other Tolars are buried.

A History of the Edwards Family of Gadsden County Florida by Nell Jones Carter, Tallahassee, Fl 1967, pg 1:

Listed among early settlers of the western half of Gadsden County (many from Telfair Co., Ga):
a **Mr Holland** and **Edward Inman**.

Note: Edward Inman had an 1844 land patent in NE Gadsden near Havana-Concord before he moved to western Gadsden.

There was a BLM land patent granted to a Caroline Holland 7/28/1838 for 40 acres (Lot 5) in S23 1-N 2-W on the county line between Gadsden and Leon (lists in both counties), along the Ochlochonee River. In 1843, William Holland, Jr bought Lot 4 (adjoining?) in that same section. In 1846, a William Holland appears on the Gadsden Tax List, paying tax on 1 male between 21 and 50. He may have turned 50 because in 1847 he was on the list but not taxed for any male between 21 and 50. He does not appear again after 1847 and he was not on the voter list of 1845.

This is the Caroline Holland who married Elijah Bryan 4 May 1837 in Leon County. They were not found in Leon Co. in 1850 or 1860 South Georgia. An "L" and Caroline Bryant are found in Decatur Co. Ga in 1850, but do not look right to be the same people. Caroline Holland Bryan was probably daughter of the William Holland listed on 1830 and 1840 Leon County census and probably sister to William, Jr.

1840: Caroline Holland's husband Elijah Bryan is listed on Leon Co. census.

I am satisfied that neither of the William Hollands listed in 1840 Leon County is the one who was on the 1846-47 Gadsden tax rolls. See their notes for reasons.

I have also examined and searched a copy of this book. Voters had to own property and had to have resided in the state for the two years prior to the election, and able-bodied men under 45 had to be members of state militia.

QUINCY PRECINCT (no Grays or Tolars listed)

HOLLAND, John (The only Holland listed. On 1850 census, John Holland, from North Carolina, was listed as a shoemaker, with wife and family.)

INMAN, Edward

The names I recognize from Concord area are in a different polling place from this one in Quincy. No other Hollands listed in other precincts.

1840 census: John Holland's is the only Holland family listed in Gadsden.

1850 US Census Gadsden County, Florida, pg 220, #636:

Susan Holland 60 GA

Eda 18, Bryan 15, Caroline 11 all born GA

Note: Susan's age is questionable. It seems very unlikely (if barely possible) that she would have given birth to Caroline at age 49-50. If she had really been about 54 on the census, as indicated by her family Bible birthdate of 1796, then she would have been about 44 when Caroline was born in 1840, a little more likely age.

1860 US Census Gadsden County, Florida:

Susan is not listed in the indexes of Gadsden County in 1860 or 1870. Both her daughters are there in 1860, but she is not living with either of them. No other Tolars besides Eady's sons are found in Gadsden County 1870. Nor is Bryant Holland there in 1860 or 1870. Susan's daughter Susan Caroline was married in 1857 or 1858 in Albany, Dougherty County, Georgia. What were they doing there? Had Susan and her two older children moved there for some reason?

1860 Ancestry.com: only 1 Holland in Dougherty Co, Ga: William Holland 30, b. Dooly Co, Ga (overseer? \$- - - \$2000) in household of G M? Windham, 23, welldigger. This William Holland (b. c1830 in Ga) not found in US in 1870. There was one William in Harris Co, Ga., b. c1828.

Using Ancestry.com indexes, Susan is not found in Fl, Al or Ga. Only 1 Holland is listed in Gadsden County: 12 yr old Washington Holland, in household of Thomas H Condry, 48, farmer, \$10000 \$18000, NC. (I have not identified his family.)

1870 US Census: no Hollands found in Gadsden County on AIS index or Ancestry.com indexing. Scanned entire county but not found. Some pages are very faded and almost illegible, but the pages around the Inmans are readable. Eady is there in 1870, but Caroline is not listed that year. (If Caroline was missed on the census, it is possible that Suannah was living in her household and was also missed.) No Tolars except Eady's sons.

1870: No Hollands in Dougherty Co, Ga . No Susan, Susannah, Suannah Hollan(d) in Ga. No Susan, etc b. NC 1790-1800 found in US.

Is Susan/Suannah related (via her deceased husband) to Margaret Ann Holland, daughter of John Holland, the shoemaker? Margaret is buried at Thompson/Burns Cemetery north of Havana in Gadsden County. She and her husband lived adjacent to the Grays of Concord in 1860. See notes on her and her husband.

Notes for UNKNOWN HOLLAND (Widow Susan's Husband):

A William Holland appears on Gadsden County tax rolls 1846 and 1847, then disappears.

Notes for BRYANT HOLLAND:

1860: No Bryan(t) Holland born c1835 found in US except for one in Wayne Co, NC in household of Calvin Holland.

1870: Have not found him on any Gadsden census index. Scanned entire county for 1870 but not found. Some pages are very faded and almost illegible, but the pages around the Inmans are readable.

1880: Not found in US on LDS online, except for one in KY (b. 1833) whose parents were from TN.

He never appears on tax lists of Gadsden County as male over 21. There is no death date entered for him in Eady Ann Tolar's Bible.

2. EDITH² HOLLAND (*SUSAN*¹ *UNKNOWN*)⁶ was born 25 Dec 1832 in North Carolina^{7,8,9}, and died 1908 in Gadsden County, Florida¹⁰. She married (1) LARKIN TOLAR 06 Nov 1851 in Gadsden County, Florida¹¹, son of WILLIAM TOLAR and ELIZABETH UNKNOWN. He was born 30 Jul 1828 in Georgia^{12,13}, and died Abt. 01 Dec 1862 in Cairo, Illinois¹⁴. She married (2) JESSE EDWARD INMAN 08 Dec 1867 in Gadsden County, Florida¹⁵, son of EDWARD INMAN. He was born Jan 1843^{16,17}, and died 29 Jan 1910^{18,19,20}.

Notes for EDITH HOLLAND:

Tombstone listing has 1833 as birth year.

These were the only Tolers listed in Florida in the index for 1860.

Notes for LARKIN TOLAR:

Civil War company muster roll records:

Died about 1 December 1862, while a Confederate prisoner of war at Cairo, Illinois. He is buried there. Enlisted 3 May 1862 at Quincy, FL, assigned to Co. A, 6 Regt. Fla. Inf., Lt Allison, for a period of 3 years. He was left sick 7 September 1862 in Lexington, KY. He was captured at Lexington, KY, 17 Oct 1862; shipped from Louisville, KY to Cairo, IL in steamboat Belle Creole, 18 Nov 1862. He was described as age 34; height 5'10", eyes dark, complexion dark. On the Company Muster Roll card for January and February, 1864, remarks show: "Left sick in KY. Supposed to have died about Dec 1/62."

Biographical Rosters of Florida's Confederate and Union Soldiers, Vol II (copy in Florida State Archives), pg 589: 6th Fl Inf, Co A:

Tolar, Larkin (b. 1828) enlisted 5/3/62 at Quincy. He was left sick in Lexington, KY and captured 10/17/62, then exchanged near Vicksburg in late 1862. He was 5' 10", dark eyes, hair and skin. He never returned and was believed to have died 12/1/62.

Gadsden, A Florida County in Word and Picture by Miles Kenan Womack, Jr, Gadsden County Historical Commission, 1976 (copy in Florida State Library), pg 48-49:

Sycamore Methodist Episcopal Church, South (Sycamore United Methodist)

... The church was supposed to have been constructed "on the site of the home built by the Scottish pioneer, Randal Johnson, who led one of the first colonies of immigrants to settle in what is known as the Sycamore community." ...

... Plans for the construction of a church began when John Vanlandingham, a Methodist minister, Joseph Fletcher, Jeff Davis and Jim Yon met at Randall Johnson's home on July 12, 1852 to discuss the matter. Johnson's place was then chosen for the building. His property was centrally located in the community and had a spring of water nearby.

... The names of some of the pioneer families who were active in the early life of this congregation were Fletcher, Morgan, Whittle, Gregory, Potter, Marlow, Ferrel, Johnson, **Rowan**, Barr, **Bryant**, **Vanlandingham**, **Tolar** as well as others.

Notes for JESSE EDWARD INMAN:

According to Gladys Clark Rowan, Sycamore Methodist Church records show his death date as "January 29, 1910", although gravestone has only 1910.

See his father's notes for census records before he married Eady.

Application for Pension 1909 stated he owned 40 acres near Greensboro, valued at \$125. Signed with his x mark. Medical affidavit said he suffered from chronic rheumatism, hardening of the arteries and incipient Bright's Disease, and was "mentally unsound or insane".
