1900 & 1910 US Census, Monroe County, Alabama: she lived with son John W. - see his notes.

1920 US Census: not found on Soundex or Ancestry.com index. Not in Monroe Co. (Note: Joe Sanders data has her living with son John W in Monroe County 1920. I have not found them there, although they were there in 1910 (her age 76). His note is probably a typo for 1900, as the only census data he references is from that year, but he calls it 1920.)

1930 US Census: not found on Ancestry.com index. No Wm, John or Sallie Watts found in Monroe Co.

Wilson Murphy's estate papers, 1878, refer to her as Sally Watts, wife of William Watts. Butler County Marriage Records Index page 436: Wm J Watts m. Sarah Watts 11 Jan 1868

Vincent and Prudence Watts had a son William, age 21 on the 1850 census on pg 224b, #689. Joe Sanders' family data at worldconnect.rootsweb has Sarah married to this William. The other Prudence Hill Watts and her children, Augustus(14) and Amanda (16) lived at #690.

Middle names of Sarah's children with William came from Joe Sanders data. He has her death date "aft 1920", so I assume he found her on that census, although I have yet to locate her in 1920. (See note above about 1900 census.) He also has J H Watts name as John Hughes (not Henry) Watts. (His data on Gencircles: http://www.gencircles.com/users/joecsanders/1/data/4969, says Sally was living with son John on 1920 Monroe County census, but I have not found him in 1920.)

July 1861 at Butler Springs; cannot make a living on account of old age and disease; age 71, P.O. Awin, Al. Property: 76 acres in Monroe Co., (Sect 24 TWP 10 R11) value \$100 and 1 house, value \$25; no personal property listed. Service attested to by W E Coleman and J G Booker on 31 May 1899. He signed his x mark.

His age was 71 on 10 June 1899, but on 10 June 1880 census, he was 51.

His widow Sallie filed application 20 Apr 1903; he died 24 Oct 1899. J G Booker and W E Coleman attested to her state as widow. She owned no property real or personal.
