Stafford. (Second wife, Amanda Stafford 4 Aug 1877 - 9 Mar 1961 also buried in same plot. Per Mr. Weeks, there were no children from the second marriage.) Actually, he may have been married to someone before Elizabeth, as the 1910 census indicates it to be his second marriage and her first, and an 1880 Geneva County census entry that may be the same person (in household of James J Gilmore) shows him to be divorced at age 25.

**1880**: Elizabeth was still living at home with her mother.
