Abraham bought 320 acres in sections 34 & 35 of T8 R24 in 1858-60, about 3-4 miles SE of David's property. He had bought at least 180 acres in the adjoining Dale Co TWP south of the Barbour line in 1837, about 7 miles south of David Powell's property. I scanned all 17 pages of Newtopia Beat 15 - rest of Benjamin's family not found there in 1860. Not indexed in Dale Co, either.

**Wm Powell and Sarah A Farmer**, 7 Oct 1852, by J S Cole, JP, pg 70, Barbour Co. (Helen Foley compilation. Does not appear in the Hathaway compilation.) - Farmer a mistranscription of Favors? Have not seen the original record, yet.

**This appears to be Wm Hanson, son of Elijah and Nancy Caroline Cox.** Mt Andrew, in Barbour Co, appears to be abt 25-30 miles from Union Springs, in Bullock Co, where the Copes and some of the other Powells and Owens lived, and maybe 20 miles from Perote. It is only a few miles south of the Bullock line, between Clayton and Three Notch.

William and several of his 1860 neighbors at PO Mt Andrew (Bryan, Rumpf, Stewart, Nobles and Warren) were enumerated in 1870 in T11 R25, PO Eufaula, within a few entries of **William's brothers John and James E.** TWP 11, R25 is in the NW of Barbour, just SE of Bullock (nowhere near Eufaula) and just south of the town of Mt Andrew.
