I have been aware of this census record for many years, but always rejected it as Elijah's widow because the ages for James E and John were way off from those commonly reported, and George's and John's ages precluded their being sons of an Elijah who died in 1844-45. If this is our Nancy, it implies that Elijah could not have died in 1844 or is not John's father. Also, it introduces a son George who has not been documented.
