Generation No. 1

1. ABRAHAM¹ POWELL was born Bet. 1805 - 1810 in South Carolina^{1,2}, and died Abt. 1872 in Alabama³. He married LITHIE UNKNOWN. She was born 05 Jun 1818 in North Carolina^{4,5}, and died 30 Oct 1904 in Alabama⁶.

Notes for ABRAHAM POWELL:

Are these Powells related to Elijah, Martha Jane & Daniel F or to Ransom? There is no Abraham Powell indexed in Barbour County in 1830, 1833 or 1840. David Powell was there in 1833-40.

No Powells indexed in Dale County in 1830 - several in 1840, including Abram. All male Powells indexed in Dale Co 1840 and born before 1830 (as shown on later censuses) were born in SC, except for George B I/J, who was born c1810 in Georgia, and Wright Powell, b. c1780 in NC:

Powell Plot Memorial Stone: In Memorium. The Abraham Powell family settled in Union County, Alabama, in 1835, an area now known as Barbour County. They lived there sixty-one years, before moving to Coffee County in 1896; and in 1900 moved to a farm just over a mile from here, where remnants of the descendants lived until 1970. Ofey O Powell, Jr (WRM note: I have found no record of there ever having been a Union County in Alabama. Could he have meant "Union Springs", now in Bullock County? He says they came to Coffee Co in 1896, but Abraham J and John W Powell were buried here in 1863-64. Or were they moved from somewhere else?)

If this is the Mollie who married Anguish Powell, then it makes sense that she was both Danley and Powell. Aunt Mirtie Owen Baughman knew Callie and Mollie Danley.
