1. BENJAMIN¹ POWELL was born Bet. 1797 - 1802 in North Carolina¹, and died Aft. Aug 1870². He married MATILDA UNKNOWN. She was born Abt. 1800 in South Carolina³, and died Aft. Aug 1870⁴.

Notes for BENJAMIN POWELL:

Leroy Powell on the 1850 Laurens Co census at #543, could be another son of Benjamin or he could be son of Charles at #542. Benjamin, Charles and Appleton R all had 1858 land patents for parcels around Grimes in SE Dale Co, NW of Dothan, where Fernie A had 1885 patent. Benjamin may have been related to Appleton.
