

# *Descendants of Calvin Coleman Powell*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. CALVIN COLEMAN<sup>1</sup> POWELL<sup>1,2</sup> was born Abt. Nov 1815 in Georgia or North Carolina<sup>3,4,5,6</sup>, and died 08 Oct 1894 in Walton County, Florida<sup>7,8,9</sup>. He married (1) SARAH BROWDER 27 Sep 1839 in Pike County, Alabama<sup>10</sup>. She was born Abt. 1820 in Georgia<sup>11</sup>, and died Bef. Sep 1860<sup>12</sup>. He married (2) MARY E J THOMAS 15 Sep 1860 in Pike County, Alabama<sup>13</sup>. She was born 1829 in Alabama<sup>14,15</sup>, and died 12 Aug 1899 in Walton County, Florida<sup>16,17</sup>.

Notes for CALVIN COLEMAN POWELL:

Birth place of Coleman given as Georgia in 1850 and 1880, NC in 1870, SC in 1885. Coleman, Abraham and children of Abraham and Sweet Powell buried at same cemetery, Old Bethel.

WILLIAM JACKSON<sup>2</sup> POWELL (*CALVIN COLEMAN*<sup>1</sup>)<sup>19,20</sup> was born 17 Dec 1840 in Pike County, Alabama<sup>21,22,23</sup>, and died 17 May 1924 in Dorcas, Okaloosa County, Florida<sup>24,25</sup>. He married SARAH E ADAMS<sup>26,27,28,29</sup> 24 Nov 1863 in Halley's Ferry, Covington County, Alabama<sup>30,31</sup>. She was born Oct 1841 in Alabama<sup>32,33</sup>, and died Aft. Mar 1930<sup>34</sup>.

Notes for WILLIAM JACKSON POWELL:

NOT PROVEN that Wm J is son of Coleman Powell from Pike, but it looks probable. Stephen Powell from Covington Co had a son William Jackson about the same age, but Stephen's son was reported b. SC on 1850 and 1860 censuses. This William Jackson lived adjacent Coleman Powell in 1870 and 1885 and only 4 entries apart in 1880.

**Florida Confederate Pension Application A4936** - 23 pages. All his signatures by x mark. (Pg 2) William Jackson Powell. Widow Sarah Adams. Okaloosa County, Florida, 28 May 1924: He enlisted in March 1861 (sic), Co E, 42nd Al; honorably discharged at Vicksburg, MS in 1863; lost left arm. Was receiving Pension #5991. She married him under the name Sarah E Adams in Covington County, Al, on 24 Nov 1863 and has not remarried since his death, which occurred on 17 May 1924 in Okaloosa County, Fl. She has continuously resided in Florida since 6 Jan 1866.

(Pg 3) PO RFD Crestview. Signed her x mark. Witnesses: TA McCallum, NP, and G L Powell (probably their grandson Grady Lee). David Adams attested that he had been present at the marriage, which took place at Halley's Ferry, Covington Co, Al, on 23 (sic) Nov 1863, performed by John B Cravy, JP.

(Pg 4) On 3 July 1924 in Walton County, David Adams and Allen T Powell attested to the death of Wm J Powell on 17 May 1924 at Dorcas in Okaloosa Co. (This would be their grandson Allen Thomas, son of Calvin Hansford.)

(Pg 6) 2 Aug 1909. William J Powell, age 68, born 17 Dec 1840 in Pike County, Alabama, resident of Walton County, has continuously resided in Florida since Jan 1865. Enlisted on 1 Apr 1862, Co E, 42nd Al Vol, and was honorably discharged at a station near Selma, Al, on 21 Oct 1863 on account of left arm being shot off by a cannon ball. Captured at Vicksburg on 4 July 1863 and was paroled and afterwards exchanged near Selma, Alabama. Was at home in Florida when the war ended.

(Pg 7) Owns 80 acres in Walton County. Granted prior pension #13 for \$125 per year. Has hydrocele, heart trouble and general disability. PO Dorcas. Signed his x mark. Wit: James A McLean and D D McCaskill. (Pg 8) J J Meigs and B R Morris attested to their belief that his property statement was true. Doctor's statement of disability.

(Pg 10) 4 Sep 1899. Enlisted 1 Apr 1861 (sic) in Capt Brady's Co, Covington Co, Alabama. PO Dorcas. Sworn to before James A McLean, Clerk Circuit Court, Walton County. Signed his x mark. (Pg 11) On 6 Sep 1899, W J Agerton and James Adams (his x mark) attested to W J Powell's service and injuries.

(Pg 14) On 11 July 1923, H D McCalum and W A McCallum attested that they had known W J Powell for 25 years and attested to his loss of left arm.
