

Descendants of Daniel Powell

Generation No. 1

1. DANIEL¹ POWELL was born Abt. 1810 in Georgia¹, and died bet 1850-1860^{1,2}. He married HARRIET UNKNOWN. She was born Abt. 1813 in Georgia¹, and died Aft. Jun 1870³.

Notes for DANIEL POWELL:

Nothing is known about this family except their appearance in Coffee County on the 1850 census and subsequent appearance in Calhoun County, Florida.

(Henry? age 11 in 1850) (Ann? age 13 in 1850; female 10-15 unidentified - cannot be Eliza C, b. c1825, or Alice C, b. c1828, because Daniel and the woman 20-30 are not old enough to be their parents. Besides, they have a dau named Eliza who was born abt 1841.)

Same page as James and Nathan Spears, William and Abel Cain, James Vaughn, John Stafford, John D Crews and James W?/N? McDuffie (possibly James Neal McDuffie who rpty m. Claudia Ann Cain). Crews, Spears, Cain and McDuffie lived in Coffee/Geneva Co.

In 1840, there were three Daniel Powells in Georgia. There was one Daniel Powell in Dale Co, Al, along with:

By 1855, Daniel Powell no longer appears in Coffee County. **Samuel Powell** is enumerated alone (1m>21) on image 10 of 27 between and adjacent to **Asa** and **James Bailey** near **Alford Leadon**. Another **Samuel Powell** (1m>21, 1f<21, 1f>21) on image 6 of 27 near people whose names I do not recognize. Only Powells indexed are: Apsey, Harrison, Jacob, Micheal and the two Samuels.

1855 Alabama State Census, Coffee County: Daniel Powell not indexed in state.

1) Pvt, Co A, 2nd Fl Cavalry, Capt Thigpin's Company, age 24; on muster-in roll dated Ricoes Bluff, 15 May 1862; enlisted 10 Mar 1862 Apalachicola by Capt Thigpin. Horse value \$275; horse equipment \$25. Present on muster rolls through Jul-Aug 1863.

2) Pvt, Co E 5th Btn Fl Cavalry, enlisted 10 Mar 1862 at Apalachicola by Capt Thigpin. Present on muster roll Nov-Dec 1863. Rmks: Transferred from Co A 2 Fla Cav as a private Sept 15. Pvt Co F: On register of Officers and Soldiers ... killed in battle ... or who died of wounds or disease. **Died 23 Jan 1864 in Marianna, FL, of disease.**
