Nothing is known about this family except their appearance in Coffee County on the 1850 census and subsequent appearance in Calhoun County, Florida.

Another **Samuel Powell** (1m>21, 1f<21, 1f>21) on image 6 of 27 near people whose names I do not recognize. Only Powells indexed are: Apsey, Harrison, Jacob, Micheal and the two Samuels.
