He married FLORENCE AUGUSTA 'GUSSIE' DANLEY<sup>81</sup> Abt. 1885<sup>82</sup>, daughter of OLIVER DANLEY and MARTHA HOLLEY. She was born 09 Feb 1867 in Coffee County, Alabama<sup>82,83,84</sup>, and died 11 Aug 1946 in Geneva County, Alabama<sup>85,86</sup>.

Notes for WILLIAM DANIEL POWELL:

Listed as 'Daniel Jr' on 1870 census and Daniel in 1880.

This is "Uncle Danny" referred to by Dobson, pg. 296:

"Killed by Chap Cain, brother of Sam Houston Cain who married Lillian Beulah Powell, dau of Uncle Danny. She brought his body back (5-12-1902) on a handcar from Liberty Co, Texas to their home. He was buried in Big Sandy Cem., Polk Co Texas, near Livingston Tx off Hwy 192 from La."

Notes for FLORENCE AUGUSTA 'GUSSIE' DANLEY:

According to Dobson, she is Florence Augusta (Gussie) Danley, who married Dobson's Uncle Danny (William Daniel Powell) of Liberty Co., TX, in 1885 in Geneva County, Al. She has Fred Daniel Powell, never married, buried at Traveler's Rest (pg 86). Pg 148 has Berta b. abt 1894 and married to Henry Bullard, Covington County, abt 1915, but Berta was not in mother's household in 1910 Samson. Berta and Henry not found on 1910 census, but found in Walton Co, Fl in 1920 and Covington Co, Al, in 1930. Census 1930 indicates she was married at age 24, making it about 1913-1914, but she was not in mother's household in 1910. Was she married to someone else before Henry Bullard?

Gussie's brother James Thomas Danley was in Tyler County, Texas, in 1900 with his wife, Mattie Gray, dau of Andrew Jackson Gray and Elizabeth Mills Smith, from Geneva County. By 1910, they had moved to Liberty County. Did they move there to help his sister Gussie after her husband died in 1902? She was back in Samson, Alabama, by 1910. By 1920, Tom and Mattie Danley had moved back to Tyler County, and in the 1920s moved on to California.

Tall, slender, light gray eyes, light brown hair. Signed F D Powell. (Same as Fred D in 1918: same birthdate as Fred D buried at Traveler's Rest, son of Florence A Powell.)

Isham David Crews, b. 1815 in Fitzgerald, Georgia, son of John D (veteran of 47th Georgia Regiment of Militia-War of 1812) and Elizabeth Moye Crews. At some point the family migrated to Alabama, settling in the Samson/Geneva area. He married Mary Ann Rouse in 1844, they had five children. Isham Enlisted September 14, 1861 at age 48 along with two brothers, Marquis L. D and James Madison Crews into Captain Henry Laird's Gulf Rangers, Alabama Volunteers. At some point the Gulf Rangers were absorbed into a regiment made up of men from three different states. Isham settled into Company D of the 1st Alabama, Tennessee and Mississippi infantry regiment as "flag bearer".

Following garrison duty at Fort Pillow Tennessee, the regiment was ordered to New Madrid, Missouri in late February 1862. New Madrid was evacuated by the Confederates the night of March 13 1862. Continuing to fight from the area of Island No. 10 in the Mississippi River, until overwhelmed by superior forces and firepower, the Confederate forces were surrendered on 8 April 1862.

Isham, along with others captured at Island No. 10 were sent North, eventually being imprisoned at Camp Randall at Madison, Wisconsin. The mortality rate was high, disease and sickness prevailed, many died. Isham David Crews died around 26 May 1862. Family legend has it that his brother James Madison was with him when he died. His youngest son, James Madison was born April 4 1862, four days before his father was taken prisoner. Two other brothers served the Arms of the Confederacy, George Washington Crews 6th Alabama Cavalry, and John Crews 48th Alabama Infantry, killed at Chickamauga.
