### Generation No. 1

**1.** DANIEL<sup>1</sup> POWELL was born Abt. 1800 in North Carolina<sup>1</sup>, and died Bet. 1850 - 1860. He married SARAH UNKNOWN. She was born Abt. 1805 in North Carolina<sup>1</sup>, and died Aft. May 1860<sup>2</sup>, probably in Florida.

Notes for DANIEL POWELL:

Daniel could be the young male 20-30 in Ezekiel Powell's household in 1830 Pike, although the woman was older. Daniel and Sarah could be the parents of *Jacob M*, *Alice C*, who married Kinion White and went to West Florida and possibly the *Elvina Powell* who married Daniel Wise and went to West Florida. Circumstantial evidence but no proof. See their notes.

4 Mar 1853: **Daniel Powell and wife Sarah** (signed her 'x') to Church of Tolyant? Hill. Donated 2 acres of land in T10 R21. Wit: Timothy S Faulk and **G C Powell**.

22 Dec 1855: Micajah Griffin and wife Mary to Samuel Mosser and **Daniel Powell** for \$480. Wit: Daniel Hataway and **S P Powell**. (In 1880 Pike Co, widow Mary Morser/Mosser had grandson James F Powell, 2, in her household!)

31 Jan 1857: **Daniel Powell and wife Sarah** (signed her 'x') to Samuel Mosser for \$200, being half of what was purchased together with Mosser from Micajah Griffin:

**1840:** No Daniel Powell found in Dooly Co. Three Daniel Powells in Georgia, one other in Alabama - Dale Co. One was in Laurens Co, but still there in 1850-60. One was in Lumpkin Co, but he had no children. One was in Newton Co, with no male children, 1 m 30-40, 2f <5, 1f 5-10, 1f 20-30.
