In Henry Co, Al, there was a George Powell, age 30-40, with 2 f <5 and 1 f 15-20 (no Powells indexed in Henry Co 1850) - same one as in Dale 1850?

At bottom of card: Confed. Arch. Chap 10, File No. 30, pg 165. No further information.

There was also a file for **Green J Powell**, Co. I, enlisted at Mobile, 10 May 1862. Also a D G Powell in Co E, 40th, only on a list of POWs, 12 May 1865, at Meridian, Miss. No more Powells in the 40th.

Possibly the William Hosea who married Nannie L (see 1900 census), but that William H has birth year consistently 1866, while James M's son was twice shown to be born abt 1868-69, age 1 in 1870 and 11 in 1880. Close. Need death certificate to determine. That Wm H may prove to be the son of **K P Powell of Pike County**.

Notes for JOHN A POWELL:

The Heritage of Covington County, Alabama, 2003: See article on pg 326 by Powell, Jack M: **George Bennett "Bennie" Powell Family:** George Bennie and Lilla were buried at Carolina Baptist Church Cemetery. Bennie's parents, **John Ashberry Powell** and **Nancy Little**, are probably the same people as this John A Powell and Nancy C. It is NOT PROVEN that John A is the same as John, son of George B J, but it seems likely. Notes on this family at the end of John A's notes.

If this John A Powell is the same person as John Ashberry, then there is a problem with Bennie and Berry whose mother Nancy lived with Berry in 1920. Nancy lived with son Bennie in 1930, but **neither Berry nor George Bennie appear on 1910 census with John A and Nancy**. Berry is about the same age as John A's son Robert.
