Generation No. 1

1. GEORGE C¹ POWELL was born 15 Jul 1800 in North Carolina^{1,2}, and died 05 Aug 1869³. He married ORPHIE ELLENDER STARLING 09 Sep 1823⁴. She was born 15 Oct 1805 in North Carolina^{5,6}, and died 04 Sep 1871⁶.

Notes for GEORGE C POWELL: Probably other children not identified.

The George C Powell who was enumerated adjacent to Micaja Griffin in 1830 Decatur Co, Ga, already had 3 boys and 2 girls under 10.

NOT PROVEN that Eliza C Powell is dau of George C and Orphie, but circumstantial evidence indicates that she might be. Her tombstone inscription is worded very much like that of George C and Orphie, raising the possibility that all were placed by the same persons, except that George and Orphie's stones say "Ohee" District when they probably should have said "Horry" District. Eliza's tombstone reports that she was born in Horry Dist., SC, in 1825. Horry County, SC, adjoins Columbus County, NC, where William Griffin, father of Irvin whom Eliza married and reported brother of Micajah Griffin, was reportedly born in 1794.

(Note: There is not and never has been an Ohee District in SC. Speculation is that it was a misconception of Horry District (pronounced Oh-ree). This lends strength to the speculation that Eliza was dau of George C and Orphie from "Horry" District. See http://archiver.rootsweb.com/th/read/SC-Genealogy/2000-03/0953916423.)

Eliza C's parents uncertain. Most likely dau of **George & Orphie**. Could be dau of **Daniel and Sarah** or **Richard and Charlotte** (Griffin?), but the Richard Powell in Horry Dist. in 1830 did not have a dau of the right age to be Eliza, nor did the one in 1840 Pike. (Richard and Charlotte in 1840 were already short one daughter to account for all those shown on various censuses.) In 1830 Decatur Co, Ga, George C Powell had a dau under age 5 and one dau age 5-10, either of which could be Eliza C. In 1840 Pike Co, Al, George C Powell had a 10-15-yr-old female and Daniel Powell had a 15-20-yr-old female, but she is more likely to be Elvina who married Daniel Wise and moved to Walton Co, Florida. All is speculation.

It is unlikely that Stephen P, b. 1832, was Orphie's first child, born when she was 26, considering the fact that she was married at abt age 18, in 1823. There were probably others before him. If Eliza C is dau of George C and Orphie, there would probably be other children in the 7-year gap between her and Stephen P. North Gano Powell (on 1860 census, Troy; died in the war) was born abt 1827 in SC and is possibly another son of George C and Orphie's. (North G's widow, Elizabeth Barron, then married Joseph Griffin, brother of the Irvin Griffin who married Eliza C Powell.) Abraham C Powell, who went to Escambia/Santa Rosa Co, Fl, near Sweet Powell, was also born about 1827-29 in SC, parents unknown (maybe George C & Orphie?).

Land:

In 1837, George C Powell received a patent for 40 ac in S9 T10N R21E that touched corners with a parcel patented by Daniel Powell 1845-58. Adjoining Daniel's parcel was Stephen P's parcel, acquired 1853-58. Timothy Soles' land surrounded that of George C and was adjacent that of Stephen P. George C Powell had at least 320 acres in Section 21 10N 21E (1839-58) besides the 40 ac in Sec 9 (1837). Sweet Powell's NW corner touched George C's SE corner, and Sweet's SW corner touched Richard & Charlotte's NE corner. Eighty acres of Richard's land had been received as grantee of Coleman Powell.

North Gano Powell's 40-ac parcel was snugged up into a corner surrounded on 2 sides by George C Powell's land. In 1852, Abram C acquired 40 ac only 1/4 quartersection NW of North Gano. Jacob M Powell, "of Coffee County" it said on the land record, got his land only 1/4 quartersection north of Daniel Powell in 1858. Then a 1/4 quartersection east of him was David White (1837), father of Kineon who married Alice C Powell, probably Jacob's sister. In the two sections adjoining David White's land, Cornelius Powell acquired parcels in 1837 and 1839.

All these Powells were nested closely together.

Isaac Griffin received a patent in 1833 for 40 acres about two miles south of Richard, George and Sweet Powell. He had many other patents between 1837 and 1858, but he was the first Griffin to receive a land grant in Pike County. He was joined shortly thereafter by Micajah Griffin who was adjacent George C Powell in Decatur Co, Ga, in 1830. The Griffins and Powells intermarried multiple times.

According to the following Pike County Rootsweb Mailing List posting, three Powells married three Livingston sisters: David Porter Powell, b. 1885, was grandson of Richard (b. 1782 in NC, age 55 when son K P was born; KP was abt 48 when his son David was born.) and Charlotte; Carl Brady Powell, b. 1894, was grandson of Stephen P, son of George C (b. 1800 in NC); Jesse Curren was grandson of Larkin W, son of George (b. 1802 in SC) and Bersheba of Barbour County.

Although tombstones indicate that George and Orphie were born in South Carolina, both the 1850 and 1860 censuses of Pike County indicate that both were born in NC. In 1870, widow Orphie is indicated as being from SC. 1900 census entries for Stephen P, Levy K and Orphie Elender all say both parents from NC, although Levy K's in 1910-1920 say SC. However, Orphie E, as sister in Levy K's household in 1910-1920 says both were from Al, so that is ambiguous.
