Levy Kenion Powell and wife F A and his sister Orphie Ellender were adjacent at #225/209.

Mattie was not widow of either of Levi K's two sons, Levi C and Marquis/Marcus C - Levi C was married to someone else and Marcus was still single, living with his parents. Stephen Marcus (41, son of Stephen P) and his Mattie (21) were enumerated together (m. 1 yr) in Orion 1900 and in 1910. Jasper E Powell, son of Stephen P, had a wife, Mattie V (b. 1881) on 1900 census, Orion.

Levie C. Powell Dies At His Home

Levie C. Powell, vice-president of the Troy Bank and Trust Co., died at his home Sunday afternoon of a heart attack. He was 74. He is survived by his widow: one son, D. M. Powell, Troy; a brother, J. E. Powell, Troy Rt.. 3; four sisters, Mrs. G. R. Herndon, Mrs. Irene Hill, Mrs. Ruth Kelley, Troy Rt. 3 and Mrs. O. A. Faulk, Troy.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock in the First Methodist church with the Rev. Selman Bradley officiating. Burial will be held in Oakwood Cemetery with the Masons in charge of graveside services. Nephews will serve as pallbearers. The body will lie in state at the First Methodist Church tomorrow morning from 9 until 10 o'clock with McGehee Funeral Home directing.

Mr. Powell was born here August 1, 1877. He attended the Highland Home and the Old College in Troy. In 1901 he was made cashier of the First National Bank at Elba. There he married Sarah Carolyn Ham on May 21, 1902.

He went to Florida to enter the turpentine business in 1918 and came back to Troy in 1920 as cashier of the Troy Bank and Trust Co., later being made vice-president of the organization. He was a member of the Methodist Church, Rotary Club, Knights of Phythias, Masons, Shrine, and Woodman of the World.
