Levie C. Powell Dies At His Home

Levie C. Powell, vice-president of the Troy Bank and Trust Co., died at his home Sunday afternoon of a heart attack. He was 74. He is survived by his widow: one son, D. M. Powell, Troy: a brother, J. E. Powell, Troy Rt.. 3: four sisters, Mrs. G. R. Herndon, Mrs. Irene Hill, Mrs. Ruth Kelley, Troy Rt. 3 and Mrs. O. A. Faulk, Troy.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock in the First Methodist church with the Rev. Selman Bradley officiating. Burial will be held in Oakwood Cemetery with the Masons in charge of graveside services. Nephews will serve as pallbearers.
