

Descendants of Mary Malinda Powell

1. MARY MALINDA² POWELL (*ELIJAH*¹)¹ was born Bet. 1840 - 1842 in Georgia^{2,3,4}, and died 21 Aug 1920 in Covington County, Alabama⁵. She married HARTWELL MARION COON^{6,7,8} Dec 1858 in Alabama⁹, son of HENRY COON and AMELIA PINSON. He was born 18 May 1833 in Newnan, Coweta County, Georgia^{10,11,12}, and died 17 Nov 1913 in Covington County, Alabama¹³.

See also his notes. No children ever found in their household on a census. Michael Neal database on Worldconnect lists 6 children for them, but I have found only three of them on censuses: Joseph, John C and Ancil G.

Place of burial: Cool Springs. Undertaker: none.

Nov. 20, 1913, Andalusia Star. "H. M. Coon died Monday in Greenbay, wife and six children survive.

Burial Tuesday at Cool Springs."

Note: This database lists 6 children, but only three are found on any census. Mary and Hartwell not found in any state in 1880 via Ancestry.com indexing. According to the 1900 census of Covington County, Alabama, they had 6 children still living of 7 born. Several younger Coon males nearby. Many Coons buried at Kinston Cemetery, but none I recognize.

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Confederate Pension Applications

H M Coon, wife Mary, Covington County (Hartwell Marion - see ADAH Civil War Service Database) His application approved 16 July 1900. Private Co A, 33rd Regt. Enlisted 10 Mar 1862 at Mt Ider. Discharged in Spring 1865. Age 67. PO Green Bay. Signed H M Coon. D N Jordon and E Lindsey (signed his x mark 30 May 1900) attested to his Confederate service on 26 May 1900.

Widow Mary Coon's applications are grouped with the folder preceding it, that of Cary Coon. 7 Feb 1914: application to be placed on pension roll. H M Coon died 17 Nov 1913 and was on the Covington County pension roll. Mary signed her x mark. W D Powell and Mrs J A Powell of Covington County attested that she had not remarried (I, J A Powell, a resident of Covington... W D Powell is William D, Hartwell's -- and possibly Mary's -- nephew, son of Mary Jane Coon and Samuel Richard Powell. J A is probably Judie A, W D's wife.) In 1910, W D and Judia Powell lived 5 entries away from Hartwell and Mary Coon in Green Bay. (Worldconnect database excerpt below refers to item in Andalusia Star of 20 Nov 1913 saying "H M Coon died Monday in Greenbay. . ." Monday before 20 Nov 1913 was 17 Nov.)

Mary's application of 3 Jan 1916 to be placed on second class pension roll: current pension #11877; her age approximately 78; says they married in Dec 1858. T D Coon (with his x mark) attested to marriage prior to Apr 1865. Witnesses: C W M? Morgan? and W D Powell. Mary signed her x mark. Application filed in office of Probate Judge on 8 Feb 1916. (See pension application of Mary Jane Coon Powell, widow of Samuel Richard Powell, signed on same day, 3 Jan 1916, with same witnesses.)

Note: The original pages are out of order here. Mary Jane is at the end of a page, but the five children at the top of the next page are not hers. Her children are at the top of the second page over, image 4 in the Ancestry.com grouping. What happened was that on each page, the households were originally numbered starting with one. Then someone renumbered the households in a single sequence and, in the process, switched pages 3 and 4, thus making the sequencing off. H M and Mary Coon are listed directly after M J's children, thus making them adjacent to M J.

Pension application of J M Coon, b. Coffee County. **W D Powell** on 13 July 1911, attested that J M Coon was over 70 years of age, having known him for 40 years. Statement on 12 Jan 1915 that he was born in Elba, Coffee County, Alabama. W J Stanley, Sr, on 22 Jan 1915 attested that J M Coon was over 80 years of age, having known him 70 years. Coon enlisted in 53rd Ala on 12 Aug 1862 at Elba. Wounded at battle of Tuscumbia, injured "being thrown from a horse." Age 64, PO Halton, Coffee County. (No date on this page of the application. Schedule of property was signed 13 May 1899 before Henry King, JP in Coffee County, but application was for Covington County. Henry G Neal attested (with his x mark) to J M Coon's Confed. service. Kenard Meeks also attested (Coffee Co). (Note: **William D Powell** was son of **Samuel R Powell** and **Mary Jane Coon**, sister of Hartwell. 1910 census Covington County, Green Bay: William D Powell, age 50 (Al Unk Ga), farmer, rents. Wife: Judia A, age 50; 4 children at home.)
