

## *Descendants of Samuel Richard Powell*

Note: It is **NOT PROVEN** that Elijah actually had a son named Richard! This is only a possibility.

### *Generation No. 1*

1. SAMUEL RICHARD<sup>1</sup> POWELL was born Abt. 1835 in Georgia<sup>1</sup>, and died Feb 1863 in Vicksburg, Mississippi<sup>2,3</sup>. He married MARY JANE COON 06 Jan 1859<sup>4</sup>, daughter of HENRY COON and AMELIA PINSON. She was born 18 Jul 1829 in Jackson County, Georgia<sup>5</sup>, and died 27 Feb 1920<sup>6,7</sup>.

### **Confederate Pension Applications**

Two separate Confederate pension files on M J Powell. In one, her soldier husband was **S W Powell**: S W Powell, Co I, 40th Ala. Mrs. Mary J Powell, on pension roll (old #7869) of Covington County, age 81, signed her x mark to age affidavit 11 Sep 1908. He died **Feb 1863**. T D Coon (his x mark) and H M Coon (signature) attested to service of S W Powell on 11 Apr 1899.

In the other file, he was **Samuel R Powell**:

Samuel R Powell, Co I, 40th Ala, Covington County. Widow Mrs M J Powell. Note on folder: "Please note - all the records in this envelope are for Mary Jane Powell except one which is for Margaret L Powell. Mary Jane Powell was 86 ½ years old in 1916 and Margaret L Powell was 103 in 1908."

Samuel R Powell died of disease during the war. Mary Jane Powell's PO address on 15 Apr 1896 was Green Bay. Signed her x mark. On 26 May 1897 her PO was Sanford. On 29 Apr 1915, her PO address was Opp, Rt #1. She was born 18 Jul 1829 in Jackson County, Georgia, being 85 yrs old at time of application. On pension roll of Covington Co (#29587). New pension #1929.

Affidavit for Margaret L Powell on 10 Apr 1908 that she was 103 years old. (belongs in a different folder)

Some applications for widow of Samuel R Powell as **Jane Powell** (her x mark).

3 Jan 1916: request to place her name on first class pension roll. Current pension #7686 of Covington County. Husband's name was Samuel Richard? Powell, married 6 Jan 1859. (The middle name is really scrawled and almost illegible, but the closest name it resembles would be Richard.) Age 86 and 6 months. Attested by C W Morgan? and W D Powell. T D Coon (his x mark) attested to her state as widow. Wit: C W Morgan? and W D Powell. (On same day, 3 Jan 1916, Mary Powell Coon, widow of H M Coon, signed similar application to be placed on second class pension roll, with same witnesses. They must have all gone down to the legal office together.) On 20 May 1918, her PO address was Sanford. May 1894 application says he was in 37th Reg't.

### **Compiled Service Record for Samuel R Powell:**

Card header S K Powel, in Gant's Co, 40th Reg't: Register of Claims of Deceased Officers and Soldiers: By whom presented: Mary J Powell, W; filed 3 Aug 1863; **died at Vixburg (sic), Miss.** At bottom of card: Confed. Arch. Chap 10, File No. 30, pg 165. No further information. (Note: On 17 July 1902, Hiram Gantt attested to the Confederate service of T D Coon, brother of the Mary Jane Coon who married Samuel R Powell.)

Note: the original pages are out of order here. Mary Jane is at the end of a page, but the five children at the top of the next page are not hers. Her children are at the top of the second page over, image 4 in the Ancestry.com grouping. What happened was that on each page, the households were originally numbered starting with one. Then someone renumbered the households in a single sequence and, in the process, got at least one page out of order, thus making the sequencing off.

These children are at the top of the page (image 3) following M J Powell. The page that should be there is on image 4. These children probably belong to **S J Gregors** with David, age 16, at #29 at the bottom of image 4.

*This is the same cemetery where Charlie Summerlin, son of Lottie Ann Powell Summerlin, is buried. Lottie & Quitman also lived in the Clear Springs community for a while, although their church membership remained in Hurricane Creek, Holmes County, Fl. If Samuel Richard Powell turns out to be a brother of Daniel Franklin Powell, then Eliza Jane Powell Scroggins and Lottie Ann would be first cousins.*
