"East of Hwy 87 near Coffee Co line" is not far from Dale County.)

He has the same neighbors: In 1910, he was at #213; Elija Fortune, age 70, was at #212; Asberry Fortune, age 41, was at #217, and Isaac Boutwell was at #219. In 1920 (each page starts counting dwellings from #1), Homa/Thoma is at #8, Asbury Fortune is at #1 and Elija Fortune, now 80, is at #2 on the same page; Isaack Boutwell is at #8 on the prior page.

A. F. Powell m. Bettie Jemmerson, 18 Apr 1900, Dale Co. Was this a license only, not executed? Is it Albert F, son of Wm C? - he married a Mary by 1880, then Emma Mathison in Sep 1900 or 1901. No Bettie/Betty Powell indexed in Dale 1910. The only Elizabeth was 66, widow of William S, in Clopton.

No Albert or A F Powell indexed in Covington Co 1880. Mary C's mother and stepfather also moved to Covington.
